Walk Through the Bible

- Print the instruction page and following pages on cardstock.
- Cut around each footprint, leaving a border.
- Laminate each footprint cutout for durability.
- Store with the instruction page in a bag or box.

Choose one of the activities below:

Scripture Shuffle:

Create a large circle on the floor using either the Old or New Testament book footprints. Play music and instruct kids to walk around the circle until the music stops. When the music stops, name a book of the Bible. If anyone is standing on that book, they're out.

Books of the Bible Adventure:

Create a "through the Bible" adventure that walks through the different genres of scripture and includes a "road sign" for each. Use the included Road Signs and have groups of kids take a "Bible adventure" with their Bibles in hand. At each road sign, have them stop and use colored pens or highlighters to mark the books in that genre in their Bible's Table of Contents.

Books of the Bible Sing Along Station:

Create a large circle or path with the Old or New Testament books. Play your favorite books of the Bible song, and invite kids to follow the path as they sing along.

DIY Books of the Bible Game:

Give the books of the Bible footprints to a group of kids and invite them to create their own game.
